

AFMMAA Academic Achievement Awards

AFMMAA provides two categories of financial awards for academic achievement:

1. **College Scholarship** - A merit-based scholarship intended for high school graduates about to enter their first year of an accredited two- or four-year college or university program.
2. **STEM* Camp Subsidy** - A partial reimbursement intended to offset application, travel, and/or lodging expenses associated with a student's attendance at one of the following camps during the one year period prior to 15 September of the current calendar year: *(* Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math)*

The purpose of these financial awards is to foster interest in AFRL/RX- and STEM-related fields and encourage post-secondary education for children and grandchildren of current AFRL/RX government civilian and military employees.

The programs are funded by contributions from AFMMAA members, friends of AFMMAA, and in some cases by contributions from past scholarship awardees or their families. The amount and number of awards is determined each year by the AFMMAA.
